RE: BARBECUING AT THE ABOVE MENTIONED COMPLEXES

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The use of portable barbecuing equipment inside apartments, on or under balconies, and on ledges outside windows constitute a major fire hazard that endangers life and property.

This is to advise you that Clark County Ordinance Number 1802, Section 13.04.350 requires the following:

Outdoor cooking at apartment, condominium and other residential occupancies with portable barbecuing equipment is prohibited within 10 feet of any overhang, balcony or opening. The storage of LPG fueled barbecues and equipment is prohibited above the first story and within 5 feet of any exterior building wall. Adult supervision is required at all times while the barbecue is generating heat.

- Exceptions:**
1. Electric Barbecues.
  2. Single Family Residences.

It is the responsibility of the property owner and/or manager to notify all tenants of this requirement. A copy of this letter signed by each tenant must be kept on file at **the complex** for Fire Department review.
